Message from the Guest Editor

Parapharyngeal space (PPS) lesions represent an arduous challenge due to their rarity, deep location within a high-density anatomical compartment, and wide spectrum of possible histological entities. The structure and complex anatomy of the PPS, in fact, makes a growing lesion capable of easily reaching a large volume without significant symptoms/signs on one hand, and to involve crucial vascular and neural structures on the other. Recent evolutions in terms of endoscopy, robotic surgery, and intraoperative neuromonitoring have widened the spectrum of surgical approaches and corridors usable for PPS lesions management. The aim of the present Special Issue is to collect the latest nuances in the management of PPS lesions, from diagnosis to treatment, from techniques allowing avoidance of complications to rehabilitation. In detail, the focus of the collection will be radiological innovations alone or integrated with radiomics and artificial intelligence software, biomarkers, and surgical treatment overall.
