Message from the Guest Editor

This Special Issue seeks to explore the complex relationship between psychological pain and suicidal behavior, aiming to deepen our understanding of its clinical implications. Psychological pain intensity, psychological pain tolerance, and social pain are central variables in suicide and also transdiagnostic variables in some mental health problems. In this sense, in this Special Issue, we are also interested in other disorders close to suicide that interplay with psychological pain, such as mood and anxiety disorders, eating disorders, borderline personality disorders, schizophrenia, and non-suicidal self-injury in all kinds of populations. We also are very welcome to articles that investigate the interplay of psychological pain with other variables such as impulsivity, executive function, memory bias, social cognition, interoception, physical pain, and stress in suicide risk assessment. Moreover, we are also interested in papers validating instruments evaluating psychological pain intensity or psychological pain tolerance.
