Message from the Guest Editors

Complement-mediated diseases drive pathology in nephrology, hematology, transplantation, and immunology. Disorders like atypical HUS, C3 glomerulopathy, and allograft injury show how dysregulated activation causes thrombotic microangiopathy, inflammation, and rejection. Advances in molecular understanding and targeted therapies have transformed management. Better diagnostics, genetic testing, and inhibitors have reshaped strategies. Yet challenges remain: variant classification, treatment duration/discontinuation, and the need for long-term safety data. This Special Issue presents advances in treating complement-mediated diseases. We invite contributions on novel therapies, trials, real-world evidence, guidelines, and clinical implementation. Topics include:

- Hemolytic-uremic syndrome;
- Paroxysmal nocturnal hemoglobinuria (PNH);
- C3 glomerulopathy;
- Immune complex-mediated MPGN;
- Dense deposit disease (DDD);
- IgA nephropathy (IgAN);
- Membranous nephropathy (MN);
- ANCA-associated vasculitis with nephritis;
- Antibody-mediated rejection post-transplant.

We aim to bridge molecular insights and clinical application, addressing unmet needs through robust data and optimized approaches.
