Message from the Guest Editor

Coronary heart disease (CAD) is one of the most threatening cardiovascular diseases to human health. How to choose the best antithrombotic regimen has always been the focus of clinical research. Patients requiring combined anticoagulation and antiplatelet therapy are clinically difficult to manage, and the management of CAD patients with complex clinical features remains demanding due to the risk of ischemic and bleeding events, due to multiple comorbidities and/or complex interventional procedures. Therefore, consensus and clinical updates on antithrombotic therapy in patients with acute coronary syndrome and/or percutaneous coronary intervention needing oral anticoagolation, such as those with atrial fibrillation, are particularly important. This Special Issue focuses on the problems in the clinical practice of anticoagulation and antiplatelet therapy in patients with different types of CAD and CAD complicated with AF, which is of great significance for guiding clinicians in diagnosis and treatment. We welcome contributions to these and related topics, including original research and commentary to inform readers of the latest progress.
