Sjogren's Syndrome: Complications and Treatment

Message from the Guest Editors

Primary Sjögren's syndrome (pSS) is an autoimmune systemic disease characterized by the destruction of exocrine glands. The lack of saliva and persistent ocular dryness result in increased susceptibility to teeth cavities and corneal damage. Ultrasonographic assessment may provide an early diagnosis, leading to a focused biopsy, contributing to an early diagnosis. Given the wide spectrum of clinical manifestations and complications, disease diagnosis can often be challenging. From a therapeutic standpoint, there are strategies to alleviate symptoms. Considering these challenges, we encourage researchers to submit original research articles and reviews focusing on the early diagnosis of the disease and its complications. Additionally, contributions related to novel immunomodulatory therapeutic interventions and symptom relief are welcome for submission.
