Message from the Guest Editors

Heart failure (HF) is a leading cause of morbidity and mortality worldwide. Recently, novel treatment and management strategies in acute and worsening HF have been published. The addition of SGLT2 inhibitors and vericiguat to the therapeutic armamentarium of HF with reduced ejection fraction (HFrEF) has allowed for improved prognosis of HF patients. Moreover, in the last decade, therapeutic regimens have also been discovered for heart failure with preserved ejection fraction (HFpEF). However, drug implementation and titration represent major threats and challenges for contemporary healthcare systems. Thus, more knowledge of the benefits of guidelines-directed medical therapies and HF management strategies is needed. The scope of the Special Issue is to provide readers with an in-depth view of the management of worsening heart failure, novel therapeutic regimens in HFrEF and HFpEF, and HF risk stratification strategies.
