Current Advances and Future Perspectives of Heart Failure with Mildly Reduced or Preserved Ejection Fraction

Message from the Guest Editor

During the past decades, significant improvements in the management of heart failure have been achieved. The introduction of new therapies for congestive heart failure has improved outcomes and mortality worldwide. One promising research area is that of Heart Failure with Mildly Reduced (HFmrEF) or Preserved Ejection Fraction (HFpEF), with new therapies like SGLT-2 (Sodium glucose Cotransporter 2) inhibitors, MRAs (Mineralocorticoid Receptor Antagonists), among other therapies. Additionally, there is emerging evidence of the existence of different phenotypes of HFpEF, and an emphasis on the importance of managing comorbidities in such patients, such as atrial fibrillation, coronary artery disease, and diabetes. Thus, the prospect for this growing field of HFpEF management is promising, but there is still much to do. In this Special Issue, we welcome authors to submit papers addressing current advances and future perspectives as well as knowledge gaps in the area of Heart Failure with Mildly Reduced or Preserved Ejection Fraction.
