Message from the Guest Editor

Endometriosis is a disease that is increasing in terms of the incidence of diagnosis and poses a growing challenge to both the medical and patient communities. The existing treatment options, which encompass surgical procedures and hormonal or non-hormonal medical therapies, often fall short of achieving satisfactory symptom control. Additionally, delayed and/or inadequate diagnosis can lead to individuals affected by this condition experiencing a reduction in their quality of life due to pain and infertility. This often persists for decades before they receive comprehensive care. The creation of certified endometriosis centers has helped individuals with this disease to access surgical interventions performed by endometriosis specialists; however, many of these centers are not yet equipped to provide the extensive multidisciplinary management modalities that are required for long-term support for these patients.
