Gastrointestinal endoscopy has seen remarkable progress in recent years. The incorporation of advanced imaging technologies, such as image-enhanced endoscopy (IEE), plays a vital role in the real-time diagnosis of gastrointestinal cancer. Continuous advancements are being made in endoscopic imaging technology, therapeutic endoscopy using endoscopic submucosal dissection (ESD) and cold polypectomy, and endoscopic hemostasis for gastrointestinal bleeding. Moreover, small bowel endoscopy techniques, such as capsule endoscopy (CE) and device-assisted endoscopy, have significantly advanced in the past two decades.
