Message from the Guest Editors

We are pleased to announce the second edition of the Special Issue “Assisted Reproductive Technology and Infertility Treatment: Current Updates and Perspectives”, which we are launching as a result of the success of the first edition, in which we published nine papers.

ART is used extensively as an aid in overcoming infertility problems. Evidence-based research suggests that 8–12% of couples worldwide are trying to conceive spontaneously despite experiencing fertility problems. Each ART cycle is complex and consists of several steps. Thus, it is crucial that this system be based on sufficient evidence and detailed guidelines. This Special Issue will discuss the development of assisted reproduction techniques, including their proper indication. Experimental, innovative, and widely used technologies are facilitating inter-professional team collaborations. Our main aim in publishing this Special Issue is to share the most up-to-date evidence on ART, to optimise guidelines and protocols in order to improve assisted reproduction technology practices and outcomes.
