# Advances in Vitreoretinal Interventions for Eye Diseases

### Message from the Guest Editor

Few fields experience constant innovative development in the same way as the field of vitreoretinal interventions. The aim of this Special Issue is to consider original approaches to diagnostics, surgical management, and the post-operative assessment of the treatment results in related ocular pathologies. Additionally, the search for parameters that are potentially useful in planning a proper surgical strategy as well as to predict prognosis will be considered carefully. In fact, several technological advances have addressed anatomical or functional issues that could be useful in supporting treatment plans and in evaluating cost-effectiveness. Topics of interest include genetics, artificial intelligence, biomarkers, current technologies extended to uncommon clinical settings, or the development of investigation tools. Both the indication and the intraoperative and postoperative management of the various vitreoretinal pathologies require adequate know-how. We hope that the articles included in this Special Issue will assist in the choice of the most appropriate strategies in relation to the type and degree of the disease.
