Message from the Guest Editor

Clinical echocardiography is rapidly evolving—from 2D morphology to quantitative, multimodal, and interventional guidance. Advances in speckle-tracking strain (including myocardial work), 3D/4D imaging, contrast and stress protocols, point-of-care ultrasound, and Al-enabled analytics now enhance diagnosis, risk stratification, and procedural success across valvular, coronary, cardiomyopathic, congenital, and critical-care settings. This Special Issue aims to showcase clinically impactful echocardiography that solves practical problems and reduces uncertainty at the bedside. In this Special Issue, we welcome authors to submit papers to assemble studies that close these gaps in terms of both diagnosis and treatment. Topics of interest include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Al in recognition and risk stratification of aortic valve stenosis (the same for mitral regurgitation or pulmonary hypertension);
- Four-chamber global longitudinal strain in valve disease;
- Plaque morphology versus stress-induced ischemia for risk stratification and therapeutic decision:
- Clinical versus echo and choice between SAVR and TAVR.
