Since its development in 2001, capsule endoscopy (CE) has shown great progress over the past two decades, in device and reading software. It is also a minimally invasive procedure and does not require sedation; moreover, clinical applications have expanded to the colon. Recently, innovative advances in CE have been made in terms of artificial-intelligence-based automated lesion detection, and image-enhanced technologies. The ultimate goal of these technological efforts is to improve the diagnostic yield of CE.
