The ultrasound-guided biopsy of gynecological tumors represents an accurate and safe diagnostic technique that is widely used in the pathological evaluation of ovarian, uterine, and pelvic masses and can accurately improve diagnostic rates. Ultrasound-guided needle biopsy refers to the ultrasound-guided insertion of a needle into a lesion and then the removal of some of the lesion tissue, followed by pathological and laboratory analyses to determine the nature of the relevant lesion tissue and how to treat it. Its application range is very wide, and it has strong clinical practical value.
