Up-to-Date Research on Nerve Ultrasound

Message from the Guest Editors

Scientific interest in the applications of peripheral nerve ultrasound is still growing. Since 2023, a search for "peripheral nerve ultrasound" on PubMed has yielded more than 3700 citations. Ultrasound protocols are also increasingly being used in work-ups for the differential diagnosis of entrapment neuropathies, traumatic nerve lesions, plexopathies, and polyneuropathies. The second revision of the EAN/PNS guidelines on the diagnosis and treatment of CIDP included ultrasound for the first time in their supportive criteria for diagnosis. In addition, there is a growing number of promising technical advancements in peripheral nerve ultrasound. This Special Issue aims to present up-to-date knowledge on peripheral nerve ultrasound with a focus on clinical applications.
