### Message from the Guest Editor

Recently, four important innovations have emerged in the field of lung cancer diagnosis and treatment. The first is the validation of the critical role that low-radiation-dose CT screening plays in high-risk subjects. The second consists of technological innovations that have allowed us to achieve important goals in molecular diagnosis, circulating and volatile markers with implications for screening, noninvasive diagnosis, prognosis and prediction of early recurrence, and response to therapy. The third consists of the technological progress and evolution of micromechanics that have allowed us to introduce and diffuse robotic surgical tools, which allow us to perform high-quality, minimally invasive treatments in complex and locally advanced disease. The fourth consists of our improved knowledge and the new applications of immunotherapy and precision treatments.

I invite you to submit to this Special Issue an original research paper or a review article on one or more of these four important topics.
