Message from the Guest Editors

The global relevance of cardiac and cardiovascular diseases is remarkable. Evidence and guidelines are constantly being updated, and, despite the focus on coronary artery disease and acute and chronic coronary artery syndromes, interest in other aspects of cardiac disease, including valvular disease, cardiac innervation, cardiac infections, transplanted heart, sarcoidosis, amyloidosis and cancer-related cardiotoxicity, is growing. Alongside clinical advances, more non-invasive imaging techniques are emerging and enhancing the definition and treatment of each condition. On the other hand, the implementation of artificial intelligence services at various stages of imaging acquisition and reporting enables the novel application of traditional cardiac imaging techniques.
