Myocarditis is a myocardial disease that is difficult to diagnose positively, etiologically, prognostically, and pre-therapeutically. Many questions remain concerning the characterization of the damage, the risk of recurrence, and the short- and long-term therapeutic management using modality imaging. This is the case, for example, in myocarditis induced by immunotherapy or those encountered during viral or autoimmune inflammatory processes, opening up a real clinical challenge.
