The diagnosis and treatment of salivary gland diseases have experienced a revolutionary development in the last few decades: in the field of salivary gland tumors. the refinement of established diagnostic modalities (e.g. ultrasound-based elastography) has offered additional possibilities for preoperative identification of malignant lesions and optimization of the treatment strategy. In cases with obstructive sialopathy, combined utilisation of established diagnostic (ultrasound) and therapeutic modalities (sialendoscopy, laser) has opened new horizons in the era of minimally invasive approaches to the patient and individualised medicine.
