Message from the Guest Editors

Mental health problems are becoming increasingly common among both adults and minors. Depression and anxiety are increasingly prevalent disorders, while serious mental disorders remain a concern. In addition, there has been a rise in the number of suicides and suicide attempts among young people. The stigma and discrimination associated with mental health conditions are phenomena linked to negative consequences across various domains and affect the entire population. Despite the significance of this phenomenon, research on stigma still has room for further development, with gaps that need to be addressed. Therefore, this Special Issue will encompass a wide range of study designs to further explore the impact of stigma across its various dimensions and levels. In particular, we welcome theoretically robust contributions (systematic reviews or meta-analyses) and/or empirical studies using mixed-methods designs, including observational, intervention (randomized controlled trials or non-randomized trials), and evaluation studies (e.g., validation of new instruments) that focus on this population.
