Message from the Guest Editor

Skin diseases represent an important field of medicine with different entities such as neoplasms (melanoma and non-melanoma skin cancer), but also inflammatory dermatitis, lymphoproliferative disorders, and so on. For any beginning of a patient care journey, the clinical and histological diagnosis constitutes the cornerstone on which to build the rest of the subsequent actions, and diagnostic accuracy is of significant importance.
