# Further Advances in Electrocardiography, Cardiac Arrhythmias, and Arrhythmogenic Disorders: 2nd Edition

### Message from the Guest Editor

Novel electrocardiographic criteria, along with new algorithms for the diagnostics and treatment of arrhythmias, have been proposed, enabling more personalized patient management, including the more rational use of imaging, implantable cardioverter defibrillators, cardiac resynchronization therapy, and catheter ablation. Progress has additionally been made in the diagnostics, treatment, and classification of arrhythmogenic disorders. Moreover, advancements in imaging and cardiovascular genetics have improved diagnostics and risk stratification; however, personalized paths in arrhythmia management are increasingly needed. Our Special Issue focuses on recent improvements, developments, and findings regarding the diagnostics and treatment of cardiac arrhythmias and arrhythmogenic disorders, including channelopathies and cardiomyopathies. We seek papers that summarize the current state of knowledge, investigate arrhythmias related to specific diseases (e.g., sleep apnea) or disciplines, and highlight potential gaps in our understanding of cardiac arrhythmias.
