Vitreo-retinal surgery has experienced great advances and innovations in recent years, such as the standardization of small-incision sutureless systems; the expansion of non-contact viewing systems; the development of new surgical tools, lenses, and vitrectomy machines; and more recently, the use of 3Dviewing systems, intraoperative optical coherence tomography (OCT), and surgical robots.
