Neuro-Cardiology: An Obligation for Combined Care of Stress and Heart Diseases

Message from the Guest Editors

Segmental awareness in heart imaging for the detection of the predominant septal base could be the answer for the missing link in undiagnosed hypertension with a high stress score before mortal outcomes. Stress is likely to produce a stress septal sign or “Triple S” on the septal base (free location from the vagus), reflecting the gray zone between chronic and acute stressful cases. Beyond excessive exercise or pressure overload in hypertension on third-generation microscopic USG, “Triple S” even develops in animals undergoing emotional stress. We strongly believe that physicians should make a note of exercise hypertension and high stress scores due to anxiety/panic in cases with incidentally detected “Triple S”. In this new Special Issue, a novel neuro-cardiological perspective will consolidate the knowledge on stress in heart tissue. All researchers are invited to contribute original works and reviews.

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
