Message from the Guest Editor

Chronic cholestatic liver diseases are chronic diseases affecting cholangiocytes, the cells lining the biliary tree, characterized by inflammation, destruction or reduction of the bile ducts (intra- or extrahepatic), and consequent cholestasis. The management of these diseases represents a complex and evolving challenge in hepatology. At the same time, the development of novel pharmacological strategies and the optimization of existing treatments are reshaping the goals of clinical management, with increasing attention given to personalized medicine and surrogate endpoints of therapeutic response. This Special Issue will provide an updated overview of recent advances in the diagnosis, monitoring, and treatment of chronic cholestatic diseases. By showcasing original contributions, this Special Issue will foster dialogue between basic research and clinical practice, ultimately promoting innovative strategies to improve outcomes for patients affected by these conditions.
