# Male Sexual and Reproductive Health: Clinical Aspects, Metabolic Profile, Environmental Factors and Lifestyle: 2nd Edition

## Message from the Guest Editor

Male sexual and reproductive health is an important issue worldwide. Approximately 20–30% of adult men have at least one sexual dysfunction (SD). Among these, erectile dysfunction (ED) and premature ejaculation (PE) are the most frequent. In addition, couple infertility affects 15-20% of couples worldwide. Alongside aging and organic causes, i.e., vasculogenic, neurogenic, endocrinological (as hypogonadism and hyperprolactinemia), metabolic (diabetes and dyslipidemia), osteoporosis, etc., also psychological causes could impair sexual and reproductive health. In addition, also incorrect lifestyle (i.e., psychological stress, inadequate physical activity, caffeine and smoking abuse, high scrotal temperature, prolonged mobile telephone use, etc.), occupational/environmental factors, and nutritional habits could play an important role both in the development of SD as well as infertility. Topics will include the epidemiology, causes, diagnosis, and treatments of SD and infertility and the role of lifestyle, nutritional habits, and occupational and environmental factors on sexual and reproductive health.
