Psoriasis is a chronic immune-mediated inflammatory skin disease with a prevalence of 2-3% worldwide. Although the diagnosis of psoriasis is usually straightforward, sometimes it may be difficult and challenging. In addition, no established diagnostic criteria exist for the diagnosis of cutaneous psoriasis. Psoriasis has been classically classified on the basis of age of onset, severity, topography and morphologic evaluation. Regarding the management, psoriasis can be optimally controlled today.
