Message from the Guest Editor

Oral rehabilitation is a burgeoning and influential subject that covers the intervention, treatment, prognosis improvement and humanistic care throughout the occurrence of an oral disease. It turns our attention to patients' function and life quality instead of concentrating on the recovery of the disease itself. In the past several decades, oral facial dysfunctions including, but not limited to, temporomandibular disorders (TMDs) and obstructive sleep apnea syndrome (OSAS) have attracted a great deal of curiosity regarding their intrinsic mechanisms and multidisciplinary treatment. Oral rehabilitation requires that clinicians have a better understanding of oral physiology and function, and that they treat oral diseases from a more systemic and comprehensive view. With the aim of presenting clinical updates in oral rehabilitation, this Special Issue searches for solution updates for clinical problems related to oral rehabilitation, in order to provide guidance and recommendations for clinical treatment. We encourage submissions focusing on new clinical methods and tools in oral rehabilitation, as well as new concepts in oral rehabilitation based on clinical evidence.
