Message from the Guest Editor

The need to elucidate the challenge of histoplasmosis has never been more pressing. The recognition of this disease by the W.H.O. as a priority fungal pathogen signifies a step change redirecting focus onto this neglected disease. This Special Issue will garner researchers, clinicians, diagnosticians and policymakers to present the prevailing trends in research in understanding, identifying and tackling histoplasmosis in a globalised world. It aims to highlight areas for further development and consider what structural and socio-economic factors are at play in enhancing diagnostic, treatment and prevention strategies.
