2017 TRAVEL AWARD

FOR POSTDOCS AND PHD STUDENTS

Candidates' Requirements:

- 1. Applicants must be PhD graduate students, MD and PhD (or equivalent) postdoctoral fellows, or juniorfaculty (who received their first faculty appointment within the last two years).
- 2. The candidate must show that he/she is performing research in personalized medicine, precision medicine, pharmacogenomics, proteomics, systems biology or other 'omics-based technologies associated with personalized medicine.
- 3. Applicants must show evidence that they will present their research (oral or poster presentation) in a conference held from mid-2017 to mid-2018.
- 4. Applicants should provide:
 - An abstract that will be submitted to the conference (conference format is acceptable).
 - Curriculum Vitae .
 - Justification letter indicating the conference that the applicant wishes to attend, costs, and institutional support that will be provided.
 - Letter of support from his/her mentor.
 - After the meeting, the awardee must provide a copy of the page in the conference program showing the abstract/presentation. and meeting badge that verifies his/her attendance.

The award will consist of **800 Swiss Francs (CHF)**, and may be used for registration, travel, or accommodation. Please submit your applications to jpm@mdpi.com or cristina.arimany@mdpi.com by **30 June 2017**. The award will be granted by the end of July 2017.
