# 2017 TRAVEL AWARD

FOR POSTDOCS AND PHD STUDENTS

## Candidates' Requirements:

1. Applicants must be PhD graduate students, MD and PhD (or equivalent) postdoctoral fellows, or junior faculty (who received their first faculty appointment within the last two years).
2. The candidate must show that he/she is performing research in personalized medicine, precision medicine, pharmacogenomics, proteomics, systems biology or other 'omics-based technologies associated with personalized medicine.
3. Applicants must show evidence that they will present their research (oral or poster presentation) in a conference held from mid-2017 to mid-2018.
4. Applicants should provide:
  - An abstract that will be submitted to the conference (conference format is acceptable).
  - Curriculum Vitae.
  - Justification letter indicating the conference that the applicant wishes to attend, costs, and institutional support that will be provided.
  - Letter of support from his/her mentor.
  - After the meeting, the awardee must provide a copy of the page in the conference program showing the abstract/presentation, and meeting badge that verifies his/her attendance.

The award will consist of **800 Swiss Francs (CHF)**, and may be used for registration, travel, or accommodation. The award will be granted by the end of July 2017.
