This Special Issue is mainly devoted to a branch of bioinformatics known as "alignment-free bioinformatics methods". This branch of bioinformatics, developed over the last two decades, is one of the most promising directions in the development of this area of science. In particular, articles on graphical representation methods, aimed at both the graphical and numerical analysis of the similarity/dissimilarity of biological sequences (DNA, RNA, and protein), are welcome. The submitted articles may contain descriptions of new algorithms. Papers dealing with different aspects of the graphical or numerical comparisons of the considered objects or focused on discussing a variety of applications of the methods already published in the biomedical sciences are also welcome. We will also accept papers related to standard bioinformatics methods and medical informatics.
