Message from the Guest Editors

However, the long-lasting, often debilitating effects of the disease, known as Post-Acute Sequelae of SARS-CoV-2 Infection (PASC), are beginning to be recognized as a significant medical concern in their own right. This "silent pandemic within the pandemic" features an array of symptoms that persist long after the acute phase of the illness, and it represents a considerable burden for patients, healthcare systems, and societies worldwide.
