Message from the Guest Editor

Acute and chronic kidney diseases are common in clinical practice, slowly progressive, and usually without apparent symptoms, and most likely result in end-stage renal disease. Alongside others, we have found that natural products, such as bee products, have well-known favorable effects on the inflammatory process and its mediators, oxidative stress, and fibrosis formation. Furthermore, their role in managing diabetes and hypertension has been studied. We also urgently need more research to identify the most effective ingredients in the natural substances that are effective in managing kidney diseases, hypertension, and diabetes.

This Special Issue will focus on the potential role of natural products, particularly herbs and bee products, in managing acute and chronic kidney disease in vitro and in vivo. The scope includes, but is not limited to, the effects on the biology, etiology, prevention, and treatment of kidney disease in clinical and preclinical settings.

This Special Issue will contain original research papers and review articles exploring various aspects of natural substances in kidney disease, diabetes, and hypertension.
