Message from the Collection Editor

As you know, CHD remains an essential component of cardiovascular disease and can cause acute and chronic coronary syndromes, heart failure, fatal arrhythmias and sudden cardiac death.

In acute coronary syndrome (ACS), there is no disagreement with the policy of considering early revascularisation for ST-elevation myocardial infarction (STEMI) and coronary angiography and revascularisation for non-ST elevation ACS risk assessment. However, many items remain unresolved, including the need for the re-evaluation of aspiration thrombectomy in STEMI patients and the usefulness of recent heart failure drugs for ACS.

In this Special Issue of 'Advances in Coronary Heart Disease', we have compiled the latest information on ACS and CCS diagnoses, treatment and prognosis, including clinical studies and reviews, to provide the current knowledge on these diseases.
