Message from the Guest Editor

Heart failure (HF) is a clinical syndrome associated with increased morbidity, mortality, and healthcare costs. Several diseases and conditions are present in HF patients (cardiovascular and non-cardiovascular). HF in the young is attributed to factors predominantly or exclusively affecting the heart (i.e., adult congenital heart disease, cardiomyopathies, myocarditis, or cardiotoxicity), HF in the elderly is the result of risk factors (i.e., hypertension, obesity, type 2 diabetes mellitus, coronary artery disease, valvular heart disease) accelerating cardiovascular aging and influencing heart and the vasculature. The Special Issue is now open for submissions (including original research articles, review papers, and opinion papers) related to cardiology as well as researchers specializing in different areas (i.e. diabetology, hematology, intensive care medicine, rheumatology, endocrinology, nephrology etc.). We kindly ask that prospective authors send a short abstract or tentative title to the Editorial Office prior to submitting a full paper so that its suitability for the scope of this Special Issue can be evaluated.
