Indeed, the existence of nuclear medicine as a medical specialty began with the treatment of thyroid disease using lodine-131 in the 1940s, which could be considered the first example of theragnostics. There remains significant controversy regarding the screening, diagnosis, and therapy of thyroid diseases. This Special Issue will focus on these controversies and new developments. The Special Issue welcomes contributions that address the evaluation and treatment of thyroid diseases, both benian and cancerous. Due to the complex nature of thyroid pathology, special expertise is required in clinical practice for the continuous development of the relevant techniques and technology. Therefore, this Special Issue aims to gather recent studies investigating the screening, diagnosis, and therapy of thyroid diseases. Any original research or narrative and systematic reviews covering the abovementioned topics will be considered.
