Message from the Guest Editors

Glomerular disorders are the third-leading cause of end-stage kidney disease worldwide. There is a need to better define the epidemiology of glomerular disorders across different regions and populations to further understand the contributing factors to glomerular disorders pathogenesis, evaluate the impact of genetic predisposition in these circumstances, better delineate the factors associated with treatment response and long-term renal survival, and refine treatment approaches in terms of minimizing the adverse effects of immunosuppressive therapy. This Special Issue welcomes both original and review papers approaching the previously defined gaps in the knowledge of individual glomerular disorders. Nonetheless, studies evaluating glomerular disorders from kidney biopsy registries from individual clinics or geographic regions will also be considered, as there is an unmet need to better define the epidemiology and prognosis of these disorders in distinct parts of the world.
