Potential topics include, but are not limited to: perpendicular magnetic anisotropy thin films; fabrication of magnetic tunnel junctions; characterization of the magnetic and structural properties of magnetic tunnel junctions; bit-patterned media for hard disk drives; block copolymer templating of high-coercivity perpendicular thin films; rare-earth-free high-magnetic-strength thin films.
