We are pleased to announce that *Mathematics* is now inviting nominations for the *Mathematics* 2021 Young Investigator Award. This prize will be given to one young investigator in recognition of their excellence in the field of mathematics. All nominations will be assessed by an Award Committee of *Mathematics*.

The prize:

- 2000 CHF (Swiss Francs);
- Option to publish one paper free of charge in *Mathematics* after peer review before the end of 2022;
- An engraved plaque.

Eligibility and Requirements:

- Hold a PhD degree and be below 35 years of age prior to 31 December 2020;
- Have ground-breaking research and a significant contribution to the advancement of mathematics;
- Candidates must be nominated by senior researchers, research directors, or department heads.

List of Documents for Nomination:

- Detailed Curriculum Vitae including an updated publication list and a list of the researcher's own research grants;
- Birth certificate or other proof of age;
- Scanned copy of doctorate certificate;
- Signed nomination letters from two established senior scientists.

Schedule:

- Open for nominations: 8 February 2021;
- Nomination deadline: 30 April 2022;
- Winners announced: 30 June 2022.
