Dear Colleagues,

We are pleased to announce the "Mathematics 2021 Best Paper Award" for research and review articles published in Mathematics from 1 January 2021 to 31 December 2021. Six papers will be selected to receive these awards. The papers will be selected after thorough evaluation by the journal Award Committee led by the Editor-in-Chief, Prof. Dr. Francisco Chiclana, and the winners will be announced by 31 March 2023.

Eligibility for the Award:

- Papers published in *Mathematics* from 1 January 2021 to 31 December 2021;
- Open to all career levels;
- Both regular and Special Issue submissions will be considered.

Selection Criteria:

The papers will be selected by the journal Award Committee according to the following criteria (data source: Web of Science (Clarivate Analytics)):

- Scientific merit and broad impact;
- Relevance to the journal's field;
- Originality of the research objectives and/or the ideas presented;
- Creativity of the study design or uniqueness of the approaches and concepts;
- Clarity of presentation;
- Citation and download rates in 2022.

Prizes:

- First Prize (one paper): 800 CHF
- Second Prize (two papers): 500 CHF each
- Third Prize (three papers): 300 CHF each

Additionally, the six winners (the corresponding author of each paper) will receive a certificate and an offer to publish a paper free of charge in *Mathematics* before the end of 2023.

The winners will be announced on the journal website in March 2023.
