# Lupus Nephritis: Diagnosis and Treatment

### Message from the Guest Editor

This Special Issue will focus on diagnostic challenges and advancements in lupus nephritis across three key areas. First, it will explore the clinical presentation of systemic lupus erythematosus patients with renal involvement, highlighting both classic and atypical features that may warrant a renal biopsy.

Second, contributions will examine the serological landscape associated with nephritis, discussing the predictive value of biomarkers like anti-dsDNA antibodies and complement levels, as well as their role in assessing the risk and timing of nephritis onset.

Lastly, the issue will address the interpretation of histological lesions in lupus nephritis, including updates to classification systems and insights into clinico-pathological correlations. Emphasis will be placed on how specific glomerular, tubulointerstitial, and vascular lesions can guide prognosis and treatment decisions, providing a comprehensive framework for diagnosing lupus nephritis.
