We are pleased to announce that *Molecules* is now inviting nominations for the *Molecules* 2022 Young Investigator Award. This prize will be given to one young investigator in recognition of excellence in all related fields of chemistry. All nominations will be assessed by the Award Evaluation Committee led by the journal's Editor-in-Chief, Prof. Dr. Farid Chemat.

The Prize:

- CHF 2000 (Swiss francs);
- Option to publish one paper free of charge in *Molecules* after peer review before 30 June 2023;
- An engraved plaque.

Eligibility and Requirements:

- Must have a PhD degree;
- Must have received a PhD degree no more than 10 years prior to 31 December 2022;
- Must have produced ground-breaking research and made a significant contribution to the advancement of chemistry;
- Candidates must be nominated by senior scientists.

List of Documents for Nomination

- Detailed curriculum vitae, including an updated publication list and a list of the researcher's own research grants;
- Scanned copy of doctorate certificate;
- Signed nomination letters from two established senior scientists.

Schedule

Open for nominations: 25 March 2022. Nomination deadline: 31 August 2022. Winner announcement: 31 October 2022.
