Nutrition in Paediatric Oncology

Message from the Guest Editors

On 24 October 2025, the International Society of Paediatric Oncology (SIOP) Nutrition Network, together with Prinses Máxima Center and the International Initiative for Pediatrics and Nutrition (IIPAN), organised the first SIOP Nutrition Research Forum held in Princess Máxima Center for Paediatric Oncology (Utrecht, Netherlands). The event brought together over 50 international experts from high- and low-middle-income countries to define the global nutrition research strategy for paediatric oncology. The forum included presentations on key emerging areas such as body composition, prehabilitation, microbiome and micronutrients, nutritional assessment tools, and guideline development, alongside interdisciplinary sessions linking nutrition with pharmacology, rehabilitation, radiation oncology and ARIA. Discussions culminated in three working groups on prehabilitation, drug dosing and body composition, and Advocacy, each outlining collaborative priorities for the next five years.

The Special Issue aims to capture this momentum by bringing together original research, systematic reviews and position papers that shape the future of nutritional science and practice in childhood cancer.
