Message from the Guest Editors

This Research Topic's primary goal is to increase our knowledge of the role of diet in the prevention of agerelated cognitive decline, with a particular focus on Alzheimer's Disease neuropathology, by exploring underpinning mechanisms to characterize dietary pattern and lifestyle factors able to counteract the dreadful consequences of aging. Furthermore, we want to give space to innovative research on the biological mechanisms of nutrients for therapeutic use, not only for cognitive disorders but also for the management of ADrelated behavioral disturbance. Finally, because neuropathological changes occur decades before the onset of clinical manifestation of cognitive disorders, we encourage authors to describe the impact of diet in terms of lifespan perspective. Our overarching aim is to build a comprehensive framework where theory, diverse methodological analyses, perspectives and new technological advancements could converge. We welcome reviews (systematic and narrative) and mini reviews, original research papers (in vitro and in vivo), perspective papers, hypothesis and theory papers, methods papers and case reports.
