### Message from the Guest Editor

This Special Issue aims to explore the potential of bioactive nutrients and nutraceuticals in managing and treating inflammatory disorders. The scope of the current Special Issue includes the following topics: 1. Mechanistic studies of anti-inflammatory bioactive nutrients and nutraceuticals through modulating key inflammatory pathways such as COX-2/PG, NF- $\kappa$ B, MAPK, JAK/STAT, TLR, NLRP3 inflammasomes, and cytokine release. 2. Chronic inflammatory disorders including rheumatoid arthritis (RA), inflammatory bowel diseases (IBDs), systemic lupus erythematosus (SLE), psoriasis, chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD), multiple sclerosis (MS), atherosclerosis, inflammation-driven cancers, and neurological inflammation. 3. Translational research towards developing bioactive nutrients and nutraceuticals-based anti-inflammatory preparations, including preclinical and clinical studies, formulations, and delivery systems.
