We are pleased to announce this Special Issue of *Nutrients* devoted to discussing the epidemiology, risk factors, and impact of micronutrient deficiencies on the health and developmental outcomes of women and children across their life course. Additionally, the series will also consider potential solutions and interventions that can help address the challenge. We are especially keen to receive submissions that include innovations in improved diagnostics and population-based surveys. Studies including large-scale interventions through public health and nutrition programs and dietary strategies, both educational and supplementation strategies, are welcome. Studies and micronutrient impact evaluations from fortification approaches will also be considered. While the Special Issue will focus on issues of low- and middle-income countries, submissions are welcome from all geographies addressing populations at risk, including high-income countries. We would also encourage authors to submit a letter of enquiry and abstract citing the Special Issue in advance.
