Message from the Guest Editors

Gout is a form of inflammatory joint disease that affects many people. It is characterized by hyperuricemia, which has long been linked to purine metabolism or renal excretion of uric acid. The first aim of this Special Issue is to update knowledge on the relationship between diet and hyperuricemia, focusing on dietary factors associated with anti-inflammatory effects. The second aim is to explore the effects of dietary interventions for gout on cardiovascular risk and renal insufficiency. In addition, we will explore novel associations with the microbiome. We welcome different types of manuscript submissions, including original research articles and up-to-date reviews (systematic reviews and meta-analyses).
