The topics may include but not be limited to the study of molecules extracted from plants used to treat different types of pathologies as inflammatory diseases, bone diseases, cancer, cardiovascular disease, obesity and weight control, diabetes, immunometabolism, hyperlipidemic diseases, skin diseases, and quality of life.
