2019 TRAVEL AVARDS FOR POSTDOCS AND PHD STUDENTS

Candidates' Requirements:

- Applicants must be PhD students and postdoctoral fellows, working in the field of pathogens.
- Applicants must plan to participate in an international conference in 2019 to present their research (oral or poster presentation).

Applicants are required to submit the following documents:

- The abstract of the oral or poster presentation for the conference, indicating the conference name and website.
- CV, including a complete list of publications.
- A justification letter (max. 500 words) describing the focus of their research and what benefits they could get from attending the conference.
- A letter of recommendation (max. 400 words) from a supervisor or PI. The supervisor or PI should sign and confirm that the applicant fulfills all requirements.

Please submit your applications to pathogens@mdpi.com by 30 November 2018.

The winners will be informed via email and announced on the homepage of *Pathogens* in **February 2019**.

Each award will consist of one certificate and 800 CHF (or 810 USD/720 EUR).
